

The Database Administrator (DBA) designs logical and physical databases and coordinates database development as part of project team.

The DBA manages and implements all changes to the database models as well as the physical databases and is responsible for developing and implementing stored procedures, triggers, and other database programs to facilitate the retrieval of information from the database.

The DBA position is required to be on call 24/7 to respond to all database production and development requirements that may arise.

REQUIREMENTS:

- * Minimum of a bachelor's degree in a technical major such as Computer Science, Engineering, or Mathematics
- * Prior project experience implementing client-server, multi-user relational database engines using conceptual and physical modeling techniques.
- * Experience with MS SQL server 2000, 2005/2008; Sybase ASA experience a plus
- * Experience with one and two-way data replication across heterogeneous local and remote systems; Mobilink experience a plus.
- * Demonstrate an advanced working knowledge of ANSI SQL and familiarity with relational modeling tools such as PowerDesigner or ERWin
- * Proficient developing server-based stored procedures or other application code for both administrative functions and server-centric application programs
- * Minimum of 5 to 10 years experience as a SQL Server DBA
